**ICF SHURAH'S
GENERAL RULES AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

ADDENDUM 4

PREAMBLE: In accordance with the ICF Bylaws, Article IV: Board of Directors, Section 1, the ICF Shurah is empowered to: establish overall policy and direction of the ICF; to define its mission, goals, and objectives; to assign priorities to those goals and objectives; to approve major personnel policies; to review and approve the budget; and to raise financial resources required to meet the ICF's goals and objectives. In accordance with these stated powers, as well as those specifically outlined in Article IV: Sections 2, 9, and 11, the ICF Shurah hereby resolves as follows:

ENTITLEMENT TO JANAZAH AND BURIAL SERVICES

In accordance with the decision of the ICF Shurah, having been duly established to conduct ICF community business by a quorum of members present, the ICF Shurah hereby resolves that: every Muslim is entitled by religious right to have a Janazah service conducted for them and to be buried. This right is absolute regardless of what crime or sin they may have committed prior to their death. Although the Shurah reserves the right to decline to have someone in an ICF leadership role perform the rites, ICF will not deny the rites to be performed by a family member or other individual who practices the Islamic faith, nor will it deny use of ICF facilities or burial site entitlements to such a person. And ICF will defend, both publicly and privately, the rights of such persons to a dignified and appropriate Islamic Janazah and burial service.

NOTE: This **ICF Shurah General Rules and Operating Instructions, Addendum 4** was duly approved by majority ICF Shurah vote on May 11th, 2013, and is hereby enacted/updated by the signature of the Shurah Chairman affixed. Such rules shall be reviewed annually and updated/modified as appropriate.
